In terms of instructions issued by DOP&T vide their OM No. 35034/1/97-Estt(D) dated 09 August 1999 on the subject mentioned above read in conjunction with para 5 of Annexure-I of DOP&T OM No. 35034/3/2008-Estt.(D) dated 19 May 2009 and subsequent clarification as circulated vide MoD/D(Civ-1) ID No. 11(3)/2009-D(Civ-1) dated 31.07.2012, the Competent Authority has approved review of grant of 2nd Financial Upgradation under the ACPS to 12 Data Processing Assistants Grade 'A' (all Retd./Expired) as mentioned below:

2. Financial upgradation under the ACP Scheme shall be purely personal to the employee and shall have no relevance to his seniority position. As such, there shall be no additional financial upgradation for the senior employees on the ground that the junior employee in the grade has got higher pay/grade pay under the Scheme.

3. The above officials have an option under FR 22 (1) (a) (1) to get their pay fixed in the higher post/grade pay either from the date of their promotion/upgradation or from the date of their next increment. The benefit of pay fixation available at the time of regular promotion shall be allowed at the time of financial upgradation under the ACP Scheme. There shall, however, be no further fixation of pay at the time of regular promotion, if it is in the same Grade Pay as granted under ACPS. However, at the time of actual promotion, if it happens to be in a post carrying higher grade pay than what is available under ACPS, no pay fixation would be available and only difference of pay/grade pay would be made available.

4. This supersedes our earlier office Order Nos. A/43010/ACP/II/CAO/P-2 dated 16.11.2000 (only for entries made in the table at Sl Nos. 16, 22, 26, 38, 43, 44, 46, 49, 50, 51 & 54) and A/43010/CAO/P-2 dated 27.03.2008 (only for entry made in the table at Sl. No. 3) in terms of their pay scales under 2nd FU w.e.f. 01.01.2006. The second FU in respect of above mentioned officials is to be revised w.e.f. dates mentioned in table at Para 01.
