REVIEW OF DEPUTATION POLICY

Reference existing Departmental Deputation Policy issued vide this office letter of even No. dated 24 Apr 2009 and subsequent amendments thereto.

2. The provisions of the existing deputation policy relating to forwarding of applications for deputation have been reviewed keeping in view the manpower deficiency in various posts and other relevant factors.


3. Accordingly, with the approval of the Cadre Controlling Authority, following guidelines are issued, which shall be followed by all concerned while processing and forwarding the applications for deputation:-

(i) **Exe PPS, Sr PPS and PPS** will be allowed to apply for deputation either against analogous or higher post.

(ii) **Section Officer and PA** will be allowed to apply against deputation posts, however, the same will be restricted to ex-cadre posts carrying higher pay scale. The scale of pay attached with the posts of SO and PA will be taken into consideration while examining the fact whether the pay scale of the ex-cadre post is higher or not.

(iii) There will be complete ban on forwarding of deputation applications in r/o incumbents of other posts in AFHQ Civil Services, AFHQ Stenographer Services and AFHQ Clerical Services.

(iv) The above provisions will not be applicable to the deputation posts which are exclusively manned by AFHQ personnel and where CCA is JS & CAO.
